SPSA: 2021-2022 SPSA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Informational Principal Paredes 	<p>SPSA Goals:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) creating a safe, collaborative, and inclusive culture with equitable learning conditions for every student 2) English Language Arts (ELA) ensuring each student is proficient in reading, listening, and writing 3) Mathematics- reducing the number of D's and F's in IM1-IM3 and improving math SBAC scores 4) Supporting English Learners - classrooms should foster language acquisition and literacy development by closing the equity gap in ELA and Math (improvement in SBAC and improved grades/graduation rates). Also fluency reclassification through English Language Proficiency Assessments for California scores ELPAC. 5) Supporting students with disabilities through ownership of students from teachers/staff, access to a meaningful course of study, and instruction from teachers as well as learning environments created by teachers that meet students' individual needs. 6) Supporting black youth by developing anti-racist and restorative school communities. All 9th graders will have to take an English class in Ethnic studies. Black Students Union and ASB will be encouraged to work with one another around social justice topics. 7) Family Engagement by partnering with parents/caregivers in the education of their children by increasing information parents/caregivers receive for student grades, increasing the number of parents/caregivers accessing PowerSchool, allowing for access to registration, and increasing PTSA. 8) Increase the Graduation/Promotion Rate by providing graduation support. <p>Michael Kozma(student representative) shared that he wishes to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Encourage more class time to be devoted to inquiry and conversational-based learning. 2. Change hw to be the application of knowledge to new work as opposed to repetition <p>The benefits of this system are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. With less hw to complete and grade, students and teachers can get more sleep and participate in more activities to improve their mental health. 2. Applying knowledge to unfamiliar problems encourages critical thinking and discussions with peers. 3. More time to ask questions. 4. Increases test scores.


